Cantigny is the 500-acre former estate of Colonel Robert R. McCormick, the longtime editor and publisher of the *Chicago Tribune*. It was named Cantigny after a small village in France, which marked America's first victory in World War I.

Cantigny Gardens, created in 1967 by renowned landscape architect Franz Lipp, include nearly 30 acres of display gardens, theme plantings and statuary. The gardens recently completed a major renovation, part of a five-year revitalization project to enhance almost every area of the park. The gardens are beautiful any time of the year, but we will be seeing them at their peak in July. We will have exclusive use of the park as Cantigny is normally closed on Mondays. There will be no charge for entrance or parking but please note the mansion and military museum will not be open.

Speaker Mike Nowak With humor, heart, and 25 years of on-air radio shows about gardening and the environment, Mike will show us how we can landscape for the future - **Fixing Climate Change in Your Backyard**. We <u>can</u> be part of the solution.
