The Landscape Design Council invites you on a guided tour of the Cantigny gardens. Nestled among 29 acres are beautiful landscapes of trees, shrubs, perennials and annuals. The estate's gardens were newly designed and rejuvenated in 2021. Most plant material is grown in their own greenhouse.

Scattered across the gardens and grounds are 48 Alebrijes sculptures, created by six artists from Mexico. These large, colorful sculptures are the creatures of the artist's dream world. Pictured here is Dog/Axolotl, guardian of the night. He is a combination of a dog, a frog and a salamander.

There is a \$5 parking fee per car. If you keep your receipt, it will allow you to re-enter the park later that day. If you're a Botanic Garden member, show your membership card to get free parking.

We will meet at the Cantigny Visitor's Center at 10 a.m. for our tour, which will last approximately 1-1/2 hours. After the tour, you will have some time to explore the park and Alebrijes on your own.

Optional lunch at 12:30 p.m. at Cooper's Corner on Roosevelt Road, about 1 mile away from Cantigny.
